 - Inclement weather may interrupt access to the course or restrict cart usage to the cart paths or implementation of the 90 degree rule. Decisions are made at the discretion of the Course Superintendent or Golf Professional.
 - Limited access to the course may occur during member events, leagues and tournaments.

- Express Member Check In. Present your membership card to the Golf Shop Staff inside the pro shop prior to play. If your card is lost or damaged, please see the golf shop staff for a replacement.

GUIDELINES AND POLICIES

The mission of Duncan Hills Golf Course is to offer a fun and engaging golf experience to members and patrons of the golf course. We request that all golfers be mindful of others and to follow the guidelines and policies set forth by The City of Savannah and The Duncan Hills Golf Committee.

General Policies

- Appropriate golf attire must be worn (no tank tops or swim wear).
- Golf shoes must have plastic cleats. Please, no metal cleats or cleated shoes from other sports.
- Alcoholic beverages MUST be purchased in the golf shop.
- Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult or receive permission from the golf shop to play unattended.
- Two riders and two bags only on rental carts.

Opening and Closing Times.

- The Golf Shop is Open 30 minutes prior to the first scheduled Tee Time.
- The Golf Shop will close when all the golfers are off the course. Closing times will vary depending on the season.
- The first starting time is adjusted seasonally to allow adequate time for the maintenance staff to prepare the golf course for daily play. Golfers are not permitted to tee off prior to the first scheduled tee time to allow for our golf maintenance crew members to prepare the course for play.
- Golfers must finish their play shortly after sunset. Closing Times will be posted seasonally to allow golfers to exit the golf course safely but still enjoy their twilight golf.

Check In Procedures

- All Golfers must check in with the golf shop staff at least 10 minutes prior to their scheduled tee time to present their membership card, pay applicable cart rental fees and sign the daily rental cart agreement. Failure to do so may result in a cancellation or delay of the tee time if other parties are prepared to play or on standby.
- During Peak Playing Months a Starter/Marshal will be on the first tee to collect receipts and manage the order of play on the tee sheet.
- All play must originate off #1 to allow the grounds crew adequate time to prepare the course for play in the morning. Starting play off #10 must be coordinated through the Starter/Marshal or the Golf Shop.
- Groups may have no more than 5 players at any time on the golf course.

Pace of Play

• A brisk pace of play makes golf extremely enjoyable to all. Play efficiently, limit your search for lost balls to 3 minutes or less and MAINTAIN your position to the group in front of you.

Posted Signs

- Signs are posted on the course to protect your safety and to maintain the playing conditions of the golf course. Please obey posted signs and keep carts 30 yards from greens, tees and marked areas.
- Disregard of signs and disregard of posted signs will result in a warning letter for the 1st offense. The 2nd offense will be met with a \$20 fine. The 3rd offense will be met with a membership reviewal and possible termination of your membership uof the Duncan Hills Golf Committee.
- Carts must remain on the cart path on all par threes.

Use of Golf Carts

- Golf carts are to be driven in accordance with applicable cart restrictions at all times, and otherwise in a safe and controlled manner.
- Golf carts are allowed on the fairways of all par 4s and 5s at a 90o angle from the ball to the cart path. However, inclement weather or other conditions may evoke further cart restrictions. The staff will notify players of any temporary restrictions, but players are expected to refrain from driving golf carts where it may damage the golf course.
- Rental Carts:
 - o No more than two carts per foursome are allowed.
 - o No more than two riders and two golf bags per cart.

Indemnification for Damage

- Member shall be responsible for all damages and personal injury caused by the Member and the Member's family, and the Member shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Duncan Hills Golf course against any claims.
- General Limitations. Duncan Hills Golf Course shall have no liability for the physical damage, theft, or loss to any personal property of Member in any way arising from the use of the Duncan Hills Golf Course facilities, to the greatest extent allowed by law.
- General Code of Conduct. While at the Duncan Hills Golf Course, Member shall conduct himself or herself in a manner that is not abusive, combative or disruptive to other players or staff.

IF APPLICABLE — COPY OF 2020 PRIVATE GOLF CART STORAGE AGREEMENT

The following is a rental agreement for privately owned golf cart storage space and annual trails fee at Duncan Hills Golf Course for the 2020 season. Fees and form must be returned by **May 31, 2020.** Cart Storage is only available to Current Golf Members. Private Cart Owners will be issued a yearly cart sticker to be displayed on the back left (drivers' side) above the bumper for easy display. All Private Carts must have a "Course" sticker to be allowed for use on the course for play.

Use of a Privately-owned cart is restricted to the Owner, Co-Owner, and Family Members designated on a Family Membership. Guest riders are allowed and will not be charged a daily trail fee if playing in the company of the Cart Owner or Family Members. However, each guest must check in to the Golf Shop and is responsible for Green Fees.

Guest Operators and Riders

A Privately-Owned cart may be loaned to a Guest Riders under the following guidelines:

- o The Cart Owner must notify the golf shop with the Guest Operators date / name / tee time.
- The Guest Operator will be responsible for paying the Daily Trail Fee for the cart. **Exception**
 Daily Trail Fees will be waived for Guest Drivers who have a current Private Cart Storage plan at Duncan Hills.
- O Daily Trail Fees are for the cart and not a per person rate:

18 Hole Daily Trail Fee
 9 Hole Daily Trail Fee
 \$15.00
 \$10.00

Rules and Regulations regarding the use of Private Golf Cars at Duncan Hills Golf Course:

- 1. The City of Savannah, Duncan Hills Golf Course, and its employees and/or representatives are not responsible or liable for losses incurred by cart owners. You are solely responsible for providing your own liability and casualty insurance for your cart. You acknowledge that the City of Savannah provides no insurance for your cart.
- 2. As a condition of your cart storage and use of your cart on Duncan Hills Golf Course, you agree to indemnify, defend and hold the City of Savannah harmless from and against any personal injury or property damage resulting to your cart or from the use of your cart.
- 3. Storage spaces are non-transferrable. Owners do not have the authority to sublet, rent, sell, or by similar actions, let others use storage spaces.
- 4. Golf carts must be properly maintained to assure safety of Member and others.
- 5. In the event of a private cart becoming inoperable while on the golf course, Duncan Hills personnel will make every effort to assist with the cart removal provided there is adequate staff available. Duncan Hills Golf Course is not liable for any personal injury or damage to your cart that occurs as a result of said assistance, and as a condition of such assistance, you agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the City of Savannah for any injury or property damage that is incurred to the City or any third party arising from such assistance.
- 6. All players must register at the clubhouse prior to playing.
- 7. Golf cart drivers must have valid driver's license.
- 8. Golf carts should contain no more than two passengers and carry no more than two sets of clubs.
- 9. Golf cart drivers must stay on the cart paths when requested to do so and follow the rules as set forth by the Head Professional, i.e., 90° rule.

- 10. Golf cart drivers and passengers must observe safety precautions; i.e., remaining seated, observing speed in relation to weather conditions.
- 11. Golf carts must be kept at least 15 yards from tees and greens and on paths where provided. You are responsible for any and all damages resulting from a violation of this rule, including those caused by those you permit to drive your cart. As a condition of cart use, you agree to indemnify the City of Savannah for any damages incurred if you or those you permit to drive your cart are proven to have violated this rule.
- 12. Golf course management may restrict use of golf carts on the course at any time.
- 13. No outside food or beverages may be brought onto Duncan Hills Golf Course property.

<u>Violation of these rules and regulations, and other actions not specifically mentioned but deemed inappropriate by course management, may result in this agreement being voided and the golf cart being removed from storage. No refunds will be given for loss of storage or use privileges.</u>

IF APPLICABLE 2020 SEASON CART PASS HOLDER AGREEMENT

Rules and Regulations regarding the use of Club Golf Cars at Duncan Hills Golf Course:

- 1. Your Season Cart Pass is for One Seat in a golf cart and allows you to purchase the rental of one seat on a golf cart and the pass may not be shared with other golfers that are not listed on your rental agreement. The course reserves the right to fill the other seat of the cart during peak playing hours set forth at the discretion of the golf management staff.
- 2. ALL players must sign for a golf cart in the pro shop prior to their tee time and retain their receipt to present to the Starter / Marshal on duty.
- 3. Golf cart drivers must have valid driver's license.
- 4. Golf carts should contain no more than two passengers and carry no more than two sets of clubs.
- 5. Golf cart drivers must stay on the cart paths when requested to do so <u>and</u> follow the rules as set forth by the Head Professional, i.e., 90° rule.
- 6. Golf cart drivers and passengers must observe safety precautions; i.e., remaining seated, observing speed in relation to weather conditions.
- 7. Golf carts must be kept at least 15 yards from tees and greens and on paths where provided. You are responsible for any and all damages resulting from a violation of this rule, including those caused by those you permit to drive your cart. As a condition of cart use, you agree to indemnify the City of Savannah for any damages incurred if you or those you permit to drive your cart are proven to have violated this rule.
- 8. Golf course management may restrict use of golf carts on the course at any time.
